By-Law 2021-01

A By-Law to Amend the By-laws of the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association

Recitals

1. S.O. 1989, Chapter Pr30, *An Act respecting the Association of Municipal Tax Collectors of Ontario*, provides for the passing of by-laws regarding such matters as are necessary to conduct the business of the Association.
2. At the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association Board of Directors meeting held November 13, 2020 the Minutes confirmed the signing authority for the Association.
3. This By-law ensures consistency with by-laws of the Association.

Accordingly, the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association enacts this By-law 2021-01

Section 1.00: Definitions and Interpretation

1.01 Definitions: In this by-law,

“**Association**” means the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association.

“**Board**” means The Board of Directors for the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association.

“**OMTRA**” means the Ontario Municipal Tax & Revenue Association.

1.02 Interpretation Rules:

- a) The Schedules attached to this by-law form part of the by-law, and are enforceable as such.
 - b) The words “include” and “including” are not to be read as limiting the meaning of a word or term to the phrases or descriptions that follow.
- 1.03 Statutes:** References to laws in this by-law are meant to refer to the statutes, as amended from time to time that are applicable within the Province of Ontario.
- 1.04 Severability:** If a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this by-law to be illegal or unenforceable, that portion of this by-law shall be

considered to be severed from the balance of the by-law, which shall continue to operate in full force and effect.

Section 2.00: Signing Authority

2.01 The following designated positions on the OMTRA Board of Directors are signing officers in relation to banking matters:

- (a) President
- (b) Treasurer
- (c) First Vice President
- (d) Second Vice President
- (e) Deputy Treasurer

2.02 The individuals named to these positions are identified annually in the OMTRA Annual General Meeting Minutes.

2.03 Individuals may also be appointed to these positions by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 3.00: Administration and Effective Date

3.01 The President of OMTRA is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

3.02 This By-law shall come into force on the 5th day of November, 2021.

By-law read a first, second and third time, and finally passed, this 5th day of November, 2021.
